Experience is not required to start volunteering today. All training and equipment are provided by the department.

Our application process is multi-phased, consisting of an application, interview, criminal background check, and free physician's wellness screening. Upon successful completion of the application process, you will be assigned to Fire -Rescue as a Probationary Volunteer. Click <u>Apply Now</u> to start your application today.

It is recommended that all Volunteer Personnel should reside in the county or within 5 road miles of a Jasper County Fire-Rescue station. Volunteer personnel who reside outside of the County will be expected to serve stand-by time at a Jasper County Fire station on an average of 12 hours per month in lieu of response from home.
